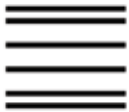
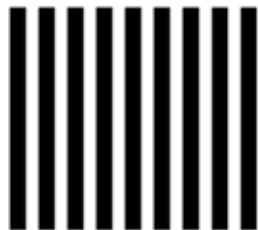


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IN ITS FIRST DECADE OF OPERATION, HSA HAS LONG LIST OF ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Noble Academy Cleveland is the only Charter School in Ohio to be rated "Excellent with Distinction" by Ohio Department of Education in 2010.

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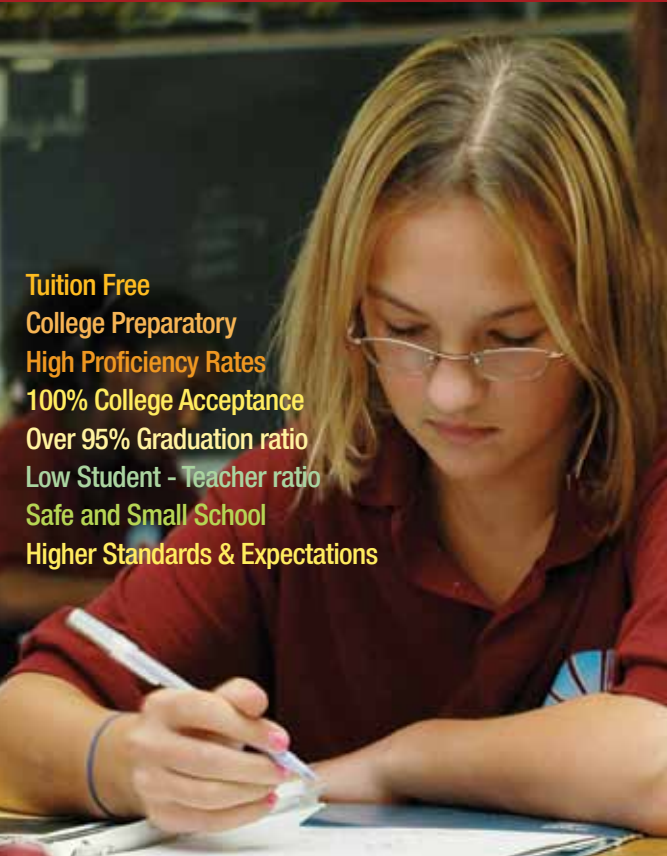
